NOTIFICATION

No. BI/2(18)/75.—In pursuance of the proclamation of the 5th July, 1977, read with the Laws (Continuance in Force) Order 1977, and in exercise of the powers vesting in it in that behalf, the Government of Sind, is pleased to make following further amendments in the Delegation of powers under the Financial Rules and the powers of Re-appropriation Rules, 1962, as amended from time to time, in so far as it is applicable to the province of Sind.

AMENDMENT

The existing entries relating to the Financial Powers mentioned in column 2 of the following table, appearing in parts I and II of "Second Schedule", as amended from time to time, annexed to the "Delegation of powers under the Financial Rules and the powers of Re-appropriation Rules, 1962" may be substituted with the following:—

POWERS COMMON TO ALL DEPARTMENTS.

Power of Administrative approval to Works/Developmental schemes.

(i) Administrative Department. In case of Developmental Works Schemes upto Rs. 4,000,000 (Non-recurring) and Rs. 800,000/(Recurring) subject to the Conditions that:-

- (i) the Administrative Secretary will exercise this power in a Committee called Departmental Developmental Working Party, consisting of:
- (a) Secretary of Administrative Department

Chairman.

- (b) A representative of Finance Department not below the rank of a Deputy Secretary:  
Member.
- (c) A representative of the Planning and Development Department not below the rank of a Deputy Secretary:  
Member.
- (ii) No expenditure shall be incurred unless there is specific provision in the Non-Development and Development Budget of the year as the case may be.
- (ji) The scheme (s) so sanctioned will be sent to the Finance Department and the Planning and Development Department simultaneously for their record.
- (iv) Where the scheme involves creation of new posts, such portion of the scheme will be got cleared from the Finance Department separately.

II—SPECIAL POWERS TO CERTAIN DEPARTMENTS AND OFFICES.

(COMMUNICATION AND WORKS DEPARTMENT).

- (I) Technical Sanction
- (i) in case of Original works
- (i) Superintending Engineer. In Highway Department Works upto Rs. 5,000,000; In Building Department works upto Rs. 3,000,000 provided the excess over the amount for which administrative approval has been accorded does not exceed fifteen percent
- (ii) Executive Engineer. In Highway Department works upto Rs. 1,200,000—In Building Department works upto Rs. 600,000 provided that the excess over the amount for which administrative approval has been accorded does not exceed fifteen percent.
9. Power to dismantle and sell unserviceable buildings.
- (i) Superintending Engineer. upto Rs. 50,000/—
